Are you exhausted from trying to live up to God’s standard only to realize day after day that you fail?</p> <p>Let God’s promise in today’s Bible reading comfort you. It promises that it is not our efforts that make us worthy to be with God. Jesus has already done that work. He carefully carried out his Father’s orders in everything. You don’t have to sweat or strain to soften God’s anger or try to win his love. Jesus has dismissed you from that wearying and worrying work.</p> <p>So, you can rest.
